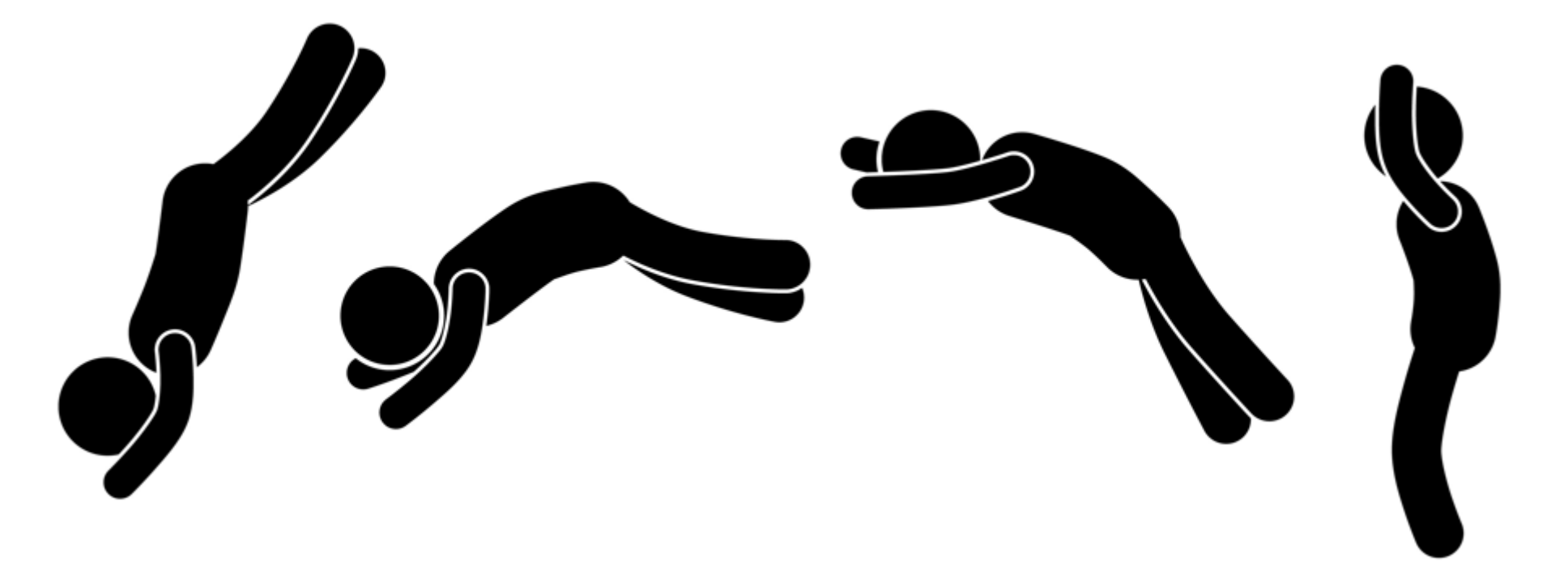
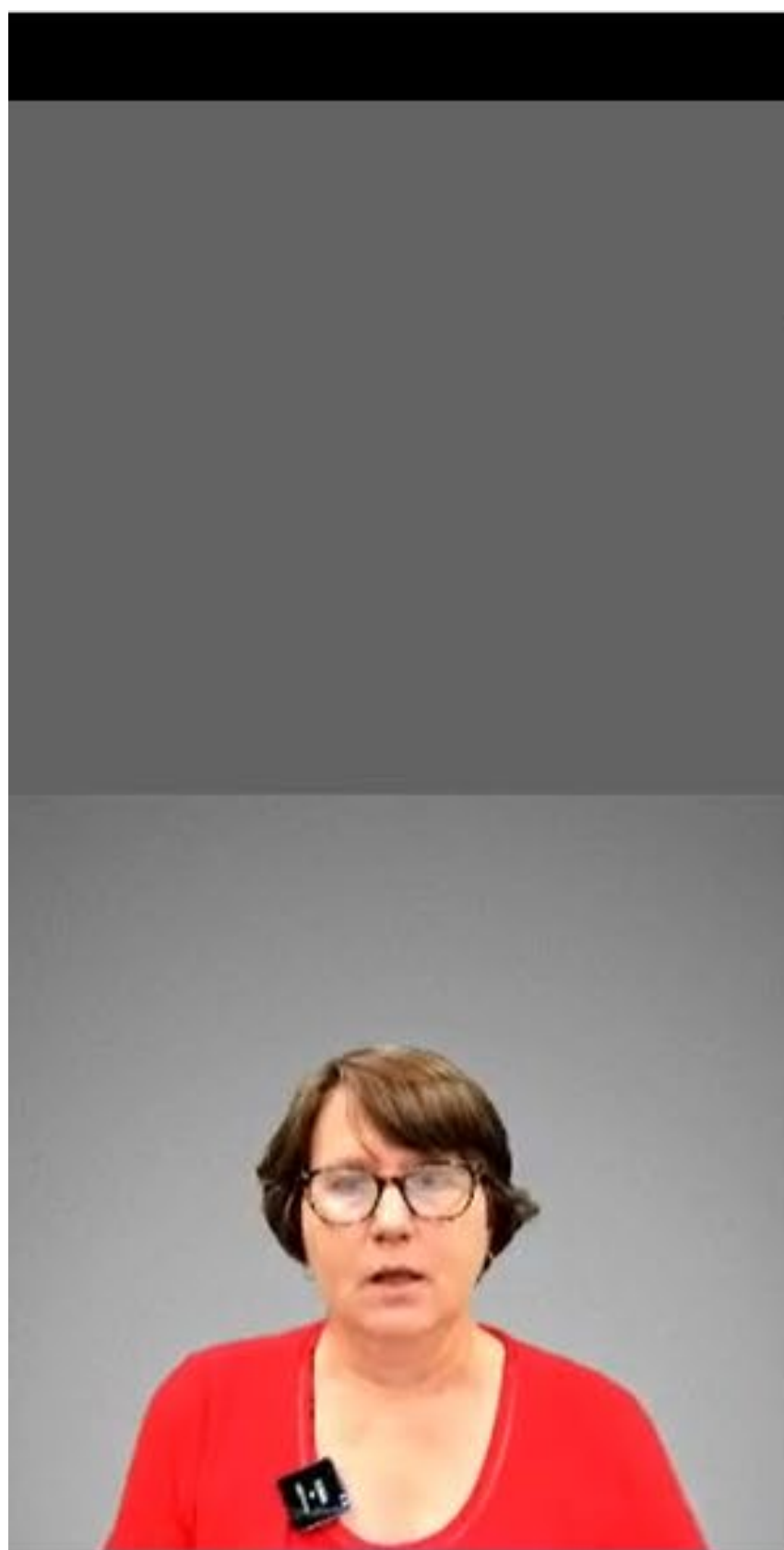


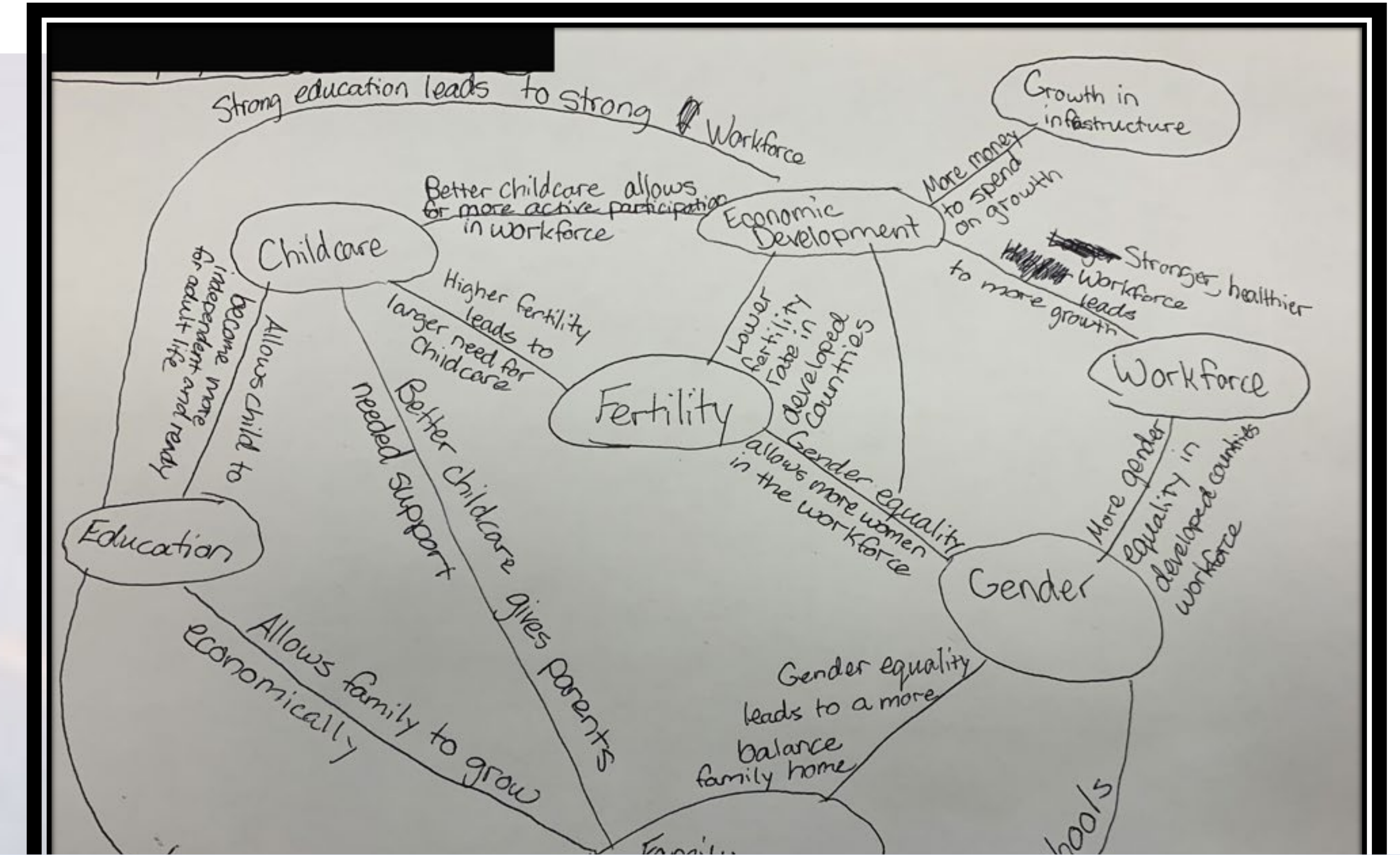
# Flipping Out

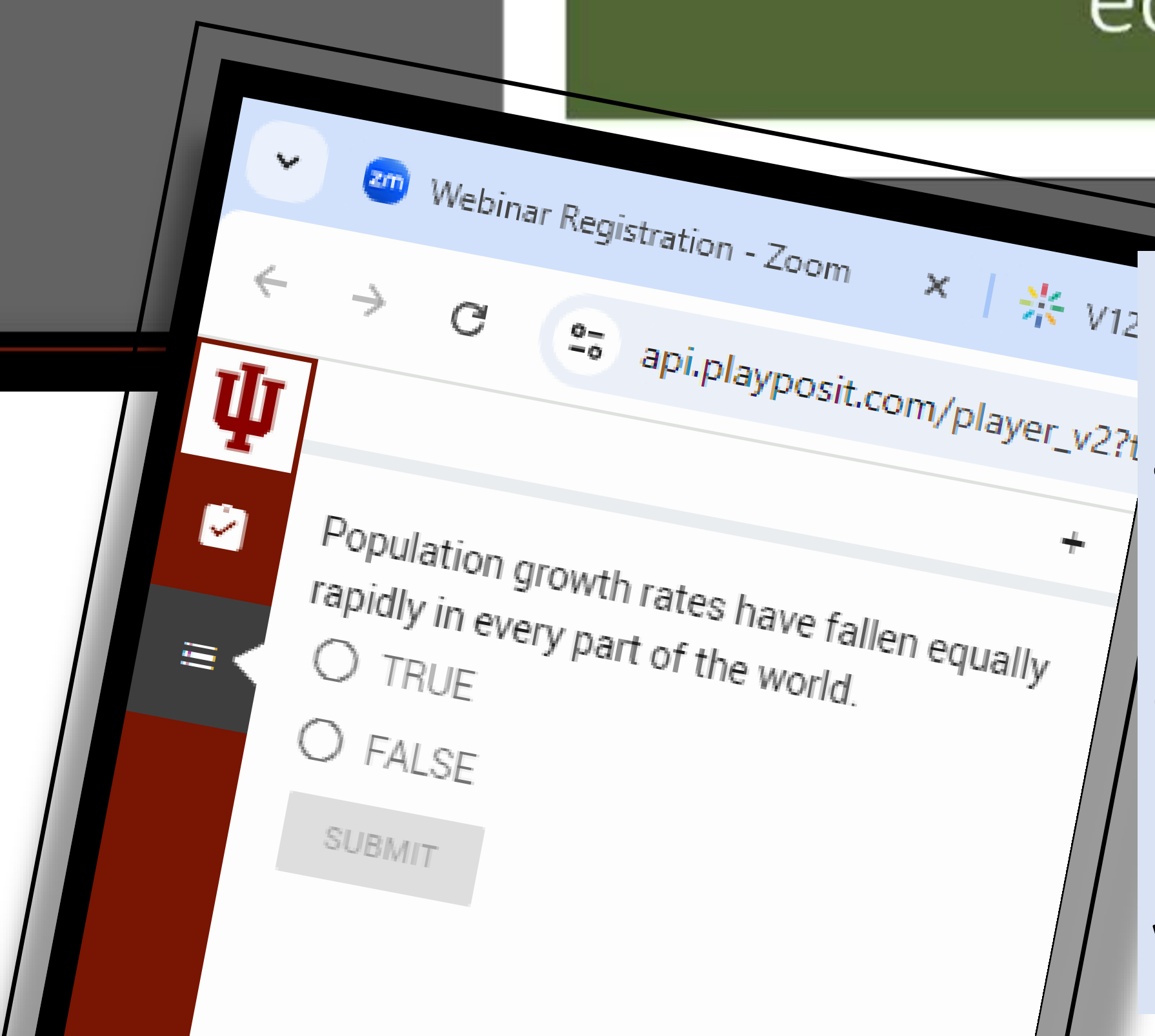


The link between fertility & economic growth

Course evaluations: 65%+ agree or strongly agree: **“Video quizzes helped my learning.”**  
DFW rates are down from 15% in 2018 to 6% in 2022.



Quiz questions pop up so that students actually watch the video before class. I also assign a reading quiz. This means students are more prepared to discuss the reading when with their peers!
